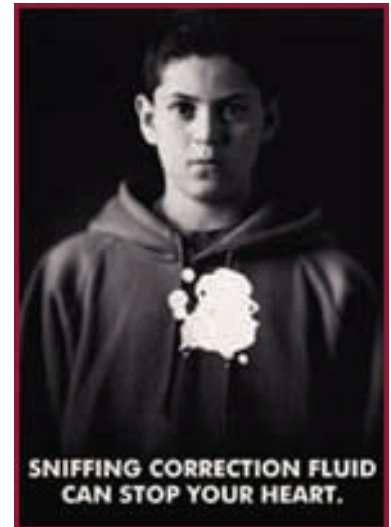


Inhalant Abuse Prevention FREE TRAINING
